Good Sprout Rescue and Sanctuary

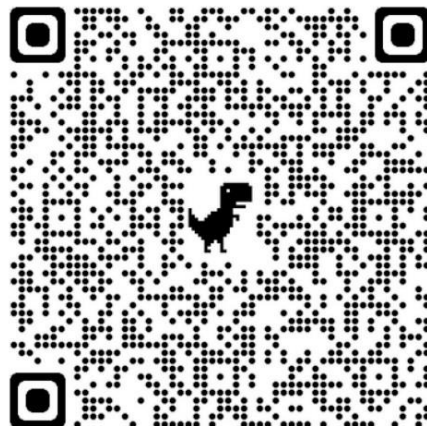
Pataskala, Ohio

As for advocacy work, Good Sprout works to end animal abuse and exploitation that happens in the animal breeding industry, as well as providing Trap-Neuter-Return services for communities with community cat populations. In addition to this, Good Sprout provides spay/neuter programs to families in need, as well as educating the public about proper animal care.
